Yvette Flores, 39, loving mother, daughter, sister and dear friend, passed away on Tuesday, September 14, 2021 following a brief stay in a Dallas, Texas hospital.

Yvette Flores, lovingly referred to as "Bird" by those who love her, was born on May 22, 1982 in American Falls, Idaho, the 2nd of 4 girls born to Leonel Flores and Adelita Flores. The family would move to the DFW area, where Yvette would live in Oak Cliff and Grand Prairie, attending Grand Prairie High School.

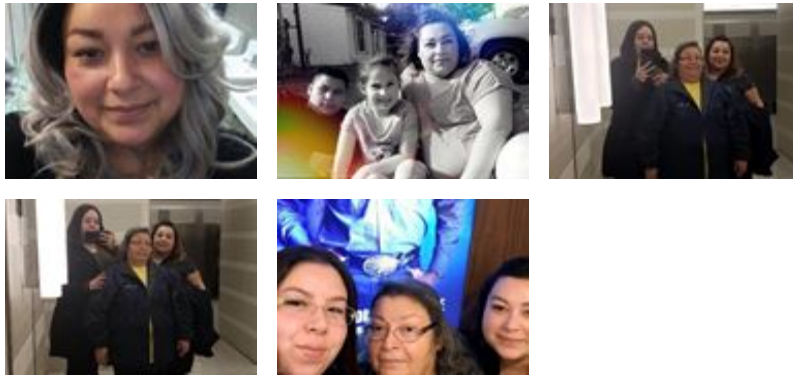

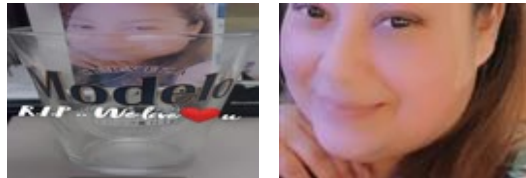
